

EPISODE: 222 TITLE: Where to Find Your Unique People of Peace

God has already placed unique people in your life that have been waiting for someone to introduce them to Jesus and life in His Kingdom.

Here are three things to believe and consider about finding your unique people of peace:

- 1. **God has placed unique "people of peace" in your life, already.** All of us have people who like us and are "leaning in" toward relationship. Some of those people will also be interested in spiritual things, Jesus, and why you live the way you do and believe what you believe about God. Trust that when you start to bring intentionality to finding those people God has already chosen, you will find them waiting! Who's your one?
- 2. God does not expect you to "close the deal" on salvation with everyone you meet! Remember, discipleship is the only mission Jesus gave us and commanded us to do. Discipleship takes time and is not a "one-size-fits-all" proposition or series of teachings. Helping those people God has uniquely chosen for you to help move from unbelief to belief about who God really is, what he thinks of them, and how they get to live because of Jesus, is what discipleship is all about.
- 3. Identify which of the four pools of people you're already consistently swimming in. What is one new pool of relationships you could add or be more consistently into your life? How could/will you get involved there and with those people? Can you identify at least one POP in your life today? What is the very next step, conversation or activity God is asking you to do with or for that person? Ask the Holy Spirit, "What's next, Lord?" then do that! Then ask him again :)
