You now get to intentionally share that love and hope with many others today who feel their need like never before. How exciting are the times we're living in?!
- 3. Pick one or two ideas from the UP, IN, and OUT focus areas we talked about and prayerfully, as a family, church or community group, start diving into these right away. Don't wait. People are lonely, afraid, and unsure of what will happen next. Together as God's children and as we radically include others, we will get through this and see God glorify himself like never before.
