

EPISODE: 173 TITLE: How to Crush Idols and Counterfeit Gods in Your Life

What is so central or essential in your life that, should you lose it, you'd feel like life would hardly be worth living? You don't have to give these idols control over your thoughts and life anymore.

Here are three key things to believe and consider about the idols in your life...

- 1. **Idols of the heart lurk in relationships, ambitions and in fears**. As Tim Keller wrote, an idol or counterfeit god is anything so central and essential to your life that, should you lose it, your life would feel hardly worth living. Who are the people or what are the things that you cannot imagine living without? That's a clue to where your idols lie.
- 2. Because of his love for you, God seeks to give you the best and ultimate "everything". God is not satisfied to leave us chasing false gods that cannot fulfill the desires he himself placed within us. He desires to be the fulfillment of your relational needs, your physical needs, your aspirations, and your future. Will you trust him for all of that?
- 3. Prayerfully walk through the list of 20 Questions from Tim Keller to start to identify potential idols in your heart. Be honest with yourself, and share your findings with someone you trust. Then ask God to identify the lies behind these idols and the truth about who He is and what He thinks about you. Hint: You're His beloved child and He has plans to bless and prosper you! Get the book *Counterfeit Gods*, and read through it in your small group or community.

20 Idol Crushing Questions from Counterfeit Gods:

1. I have power and influence over others." (Power Idolatry)

2. I am loved and respected by _____." (Approval Idolatry)

3. I have this kind of pleasure experience, a particular quality of life." (Comfort Idolatry)

4. I am able to get mastery over my life in the area of _____." (Control Idolatry)

5. people are dependent on me and need me." (Helping Idolatry)6. someone is there to protect me and keep me safe." (Dependence Idolatry)

7. I am completely free from obligations or responsibilities to take care of someone." (Independence Idolatry)
