TITLE: How to: Missional Community in Any Context

Jesus commanded us to go and make disciples, teaching and modeling *his* life to people, in every context... in every nation. He only and always made disciples in community, living his life closely with others. I think we oughta trust Jesus on this one!

Here are 3 things to believe and consider about missional communities...

- 1. The primary organizing structure of the church is a gospel-centered, missional community. That's the only model or example we see in scripture. You do not have to feel like you are somehow missing out on all that God has for you by making your missional community your main thing... Making disciples is your main focus!
- 2. God desires to shape and mature you to be more like Jesus in community with others. Your gifts, experiences and talents are waiting to be used by God to shape others' lives. And He is wanting to do the same in your life via the life-on-life interactions you have with others in your community. This will not happen sitting in rows in silence once a week!
- 3. It requires the gospel, together in community on mission to produce mature disciples. If any one of the three is missing you will see problems and a lack of maturity and external focus. One-on-one discipleship has a place in making disciples, but it will never replace walking with other mature and maturing Christians and not-yet believers through normal life as the good news of the gospel replaces unbelief and darkness.
