Module 4 | Finding Your People of Peace

Jesus showed us how to identify People of Peace (P.O.P.)

Let's look at Jesus' model for identifying people who would be disciples of his disciples. This will give us a model for how we too can find who the people God may be directing us toward who will one day become disciples of Jesus and part of our lives in community.

Luke 10: 5-9 "Whenever you enter someone's home, first say, 'May God's peace be on this house.' If those who live there are peaceful, the blessing will stand; if they are not, the blessing will return to you. Don't move around from home to home. Stay in one place, eating and drinking what they provide. Don't hesitate to accept hospitality, because those who work deserve their pay. "If you enter a town and it welcomes you, eat whatever is set before you. Heal the sick, and tell them, 'The Kingdom of God is near you now.'"

Look for people who receive and return a blessing - stick with them! Who's your "one"?

Where to look for your People of Peace


- Start by looking for those already in your life not-yet-believers and Christians!
- Look in the 4 Pools of People
- Work through the Rings of Relationship
