

## EPISODE: 369 TITLE: Conversations: Discipleship In All Of Life

Discipleship should, does, and will affect all of life, not just spiritual things and where we'll spend our afterlife. Discipleship, that touches all of who we are, requires a community of people around us who can see the times we are living out of unbelief. And then lovingly remind us of, or show us the truth.

Here are three key things to believe and consider about discipleship in your normal life:

- 1. How might you begin to pay attention to ongoing, normal life opportunities for discipleship? What recurring situations or interactions do you have throughout the week that allows you to show others God's true heart and character? Once you decide to take full advantage of these chances to disciple others from unbelief to belief about God, you'll start to notice how more and more of your daily life and conversations take on new meaning. You are always in discipleship mode... go for it!
- 2. Small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it. Jesus told his followers this, and in some ways, it perfectly illustrates the opportunity before us to see all of life as an opportunity to glorify God and help others see what he is really like. We can always keep living our life in separate segments: There's my spiritual life and practices... And there's my everyday life where I am on *my* own schedule and managing *my* kingdom for *my* own glory and effectiveness. The scandal of the gospel is that you are perfectly loved by God either way! That frees us to join him on his mission, and receive his guidance and grace, everywhere we are.
- 3. God is using everything in our lives to move us from unbelief to belief and make us more and more like his son, Jesus. Discipleship and our ongoing maturity is happening even as, and especially as, we disciple others. If you want to become a mature disciple of Jesus... then go and make disciples of Jesus. It's amazing how that works.
