TITLE: **Conversations: Gospel Communities On Mission**

Most people cannot multiply or replicate what they experience on Sundays at a church service. If what we preach, and teach others cannot be reproduced immediately, over and over, then it will never lead to maturity, growth and multiplication.

Here are three key things to believe and consider about your disciple making process:

1. **What areas of your teaching, equipping and discipleship need to be experienced in community on mission in order to truly be grasped?** Pick one area of your discipleship with others that has been relegated to a classroom. Now brainstorm ways that these things could be taught in community with others *out* on mission. Get out and serve together and then have a meal afterwards to discuss the gospel implications and what was learned. Regularly serving others as a community provides a vast amount of opportunities for the gospel to be applied to areas of our unbelief. What other ideas do you have?
2. **If mature disciples could be made in a one-to-one setting alone, or in classrooms, Jesus would have done it that way.** Jesus came in the flesh and hung out in the neighborhood. He loved us enough to not broadcast a whole load of truth from scripture at us and send us out hoping for the best. And here's some good news for the journey: Jesus said that he will never leave us or forsake us on this mission!
3. **Think through the "3 legs of the stool": Gospel, Community, Mission.** Assess which of these three are most commonly missing from your overall disciple-making process. Can you see the results of not having all three? We cannot lead others to become mature disciples of Jesus without these three components working in conjunction with one another. Now get out there, lead the way, show others how to walk in the ways of Jesus in everyday life.
