When we grasp the reality of truly embracing and living in light of the New Covenant, this really starts to speak into our Identity and the focus of our life... HIS life now lived through us. Everywhere, every day.

Here are three key things to believe and consider about living in light of the glorious New Covenant...

1. **The Old Covenant was a “come and see” experience. The New Covenant sends us to “Go and Make!”** New Covenant churches and believers are focused on making disciples who increasingly fill the world with disciples of Jesus—who is the glory of God. Let’s believe what God now says is true of us and truly live like his family of missionary servants and seek to fill the world—not just church buildings—with His glory!
2. **The completed work of Christ, and his shed blood, has secured your forever place in the family and as part of the royal priesthood of believers!** We no longer need to stand outside the party and wait as others do the work. The Kingdom of God has come and we all get to enjoy the life that Jesus has provided for us; His life, lived now.
3. **If the bulk of ministry happens, and is primarily focused in the church building once or twice each week, you may be laboring under the Old Covenant.** Life and opportunities to enjoy our authority and privilege as God’s kids, and serve as the priesthood, is happening in every home and neighborhood, in every city and nation on earth. A few hours a week hiding away in a building was not what Jesus came to die for! **Ask yourself:** In what ways can we begin, as a church or as a family, to truly live in light of the New Covenant and what Jesus has promised is now true of us.
