TITLE: **Using Gospel Fluency To Transform Your Marriage**

Discipleship as a lifestyle starts in our homes. And if you're married, how we speak the Good News of the Gospel to each other in our marriages will begin to trickle down into all of our relationships in community.

Here are the 3 key things to believe and consider about your own Gospel Fluency...

- 1. Learning to identify "the thing behind the thing" and address it with the Gospel is key.** If we attempt to just try and address the words and actions of others (or ourselves) without addressing the heart motives and beliefs *behind* those things, we're only reinforcing DO to BE. Our beliefs and false beliefs fuel our actions.
- 2. Grow in the importance of having your identity grounded in the Gospel.** Understanding the truth that who God is and what he is like is part of your own identity as an Image-bearer will change the way you see and treat yourself and others in every situation. Loving God leads to loving yourself and others for who they ARE not for what they DO... or put another way: loving yourself and others apart from *performance*.
- 3. You won't accidentally grow in Gospel Fluency.** Just like any other language, it takes time and intentionality to learn to speak, live, and enjoy the gospel in every area of life.
