- 3. Remember, these practices are not about earning God's love. They are a privilege and an opportunity to be with Him. When we approach these practices from a place of privilege, we understand that it is a gift to know God and to have a relationship with Him. This perspective shifts our focus from trying to earn His love to simply receiving it and responding with gratitude and love. Out of this overflow of love and gratitude, our lives naturally begin to change as we align our hearts with His, finding greater joy, peace, and purpose in living for His glory.
