TITLE: Men's & Women's Ministry or Family Discipleship?

Men's and women's ministries have been separated in the church for years—but the church is a family. It's time to discover how rich discipleship can be when it happens together as a family.

Here are three key things to believe and consider about discipleship with women...

- 1. We have to quit trying to live by labels and just be who God has called us to be. It's been said that uniqueness is not a barrier, it's a unifier. How powerful! If you want to find and get to know people of peace, you have to be a person of peace. Look at how God uniquely created you and where he has put you, then bloom where you're planted with those you have around you.
- 2. God is glorious so you don't have to fear. You get to live free in your identity as his daughter (or son). You are approved, you are valued. You are beautiful where you are, who you are, in your circumstance now. And you're empowered by the Holy spirit to do good works and to reveal his glory all around you. It's not complicated. It's beautiful in its simplicity, and God goes before. So remember your Gospel identity and live out of that.
- 3. Start praying that God will put People of Peace in our lives; people who are leaning into relationships. And if you already have them around you, be courageous to step out and ask the Lord, "What's next?" in those relationships. Be brave enough to step out. Go to that person and say, "Hey, I'd really like to get together and talk, have a cup of coffee." Cultivating a sisterhood and a community is pivotal. It is foundational to living and discipling others. It's hard to disciple and go to deeper levels of belief when you're not with people. One of the most important parts of having a rich, diverse community is the health of all individuals.
