

EPISODE: 536 TITLE: 7 Evangelism Mistakes You're Probably Making

It is amazing how different evangelism, done properly, is from what many of us grew up hearing in our local church.

Here are three things to believe and consider about the ways we do evangelism:

- Believe it or not, most people are very open to having spiritual conversations. But it must be in the right context, at the right time, and we must have the right heart posture in order for it to truly be a conversation that others *want* to participate in... and maybe revisit over time. Asking more questions and listening well—especially at the beginning of a relationship—is a lot more important than trying to "win" the conversation on the spot.
- 2. We must understand and believe a BIG gospel that speaks Good News into absolutely every area of life. Starting with our own! We must also love God and his glory more than our own comfort and control over what people think of us. Do you believe that Jesus' life, death and resurrection, and his loving rule in your life, is merely a convenient thing for your afterlife? Or are you grateful and have a desire for everyone to experience the freedom that you have in Christ? This changes things a lot!
- 3. Growing in Gospel Fluency so that we have Good News to proclaim is essential! Learning to speak, live and enjoy the gospel in every area of life allows us to proclaim the gospel in both words and throughout all the normal stuff of life. Get the resources and training you need and then share it with others in your family and community so you can begin to evangelize yourselves and each other. Remember that moving from unbelief to belief, concerning the truth of the Gospel, in every area of life is what discipleship is.
