TITLE: **Not Another Small Group: How to Build a Missional Family**

You really can live life together with others, like a family, in a way that brings kingdom life and the gospel to bare for you, your family and others. If there are no communities like this in your church or city, it may be that God is wanting you to start your own missional community!

Here are three key things to believe and consider:

Head...heart...hands...

1. **Your family is an amazing place to begin when starting a missional community.** Live as a family worth joining and imitating. Begin at the beginning in your own lives. Trying to organize others into a series of activities, events or rhythms that you and those closest to you are not already living will produce unnecessary stress and set you up for failure.
2. **We all long for a family;** a brother or sister who will lay down their life for us, a place where we can safely be ourselves. When we live out our true identity as a family—God's family—we offer that very thing to a waiting and watching world. Increasingly, people around you are way more likely to join you for a meal, a coffee or game night than they are to attend a church service with you. The daily rhythms of your life together is the perfect soil for making disciples!
3. **Take these 7 steps toward missional living and get started today.** Get together as a family, and maybe a few close friends and share these 7 steps with them and prayerfully get started right away. Mission happens in the normal stuff of life, with disciples in tow and the Good News dripping out of your mouth and being proclaimed in every step, bite of food, and breath you take.

If you get started, this will change your life, and the life of your neighborhood and family forever. You're gonna create an amazing life...you're gonna make a positive impact on others... and leave a lasting legacy.
